Thank you for your interest in a great new opportunity to become part of the first ever youth shooting sports team in Penn Cambria history. The Cresson Sportsmans Association has agreed to be the home field providing the facility, coaches, equipment and administration.

**SAFETY** will be the number one aspect of this team. **SAFETY RULES** are expected to be followed with **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Anyone who violates them will be not only be removed **PERMANENTLY** from the team but also nationally from ever participating in a similar league.

Our goal is to provide a **SAFE** and **FUN** group to teach or improve the **MARKSMANSHIP** of our youth and build their interest in the sport as they grow. Many colleges including local ones now have scholarships available to anyone who wants to shoot on their collegiate teams.

Please complete the attached application and return to a member of the Cresson Sportsmans Youth Trap Organization before MARCH 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020. There is **NO** adding shooters once the roster is closed. The USA High School Clay Target League sets these rules and guidelines.

**COST** - \$65 Initial League Fee and \$10 / Week to cover ammo and clay targets – \$30 of this fee will cover the last 3 weeks of the season.

**ALL AMMO** - will be supplied by the Cresson Sportsmans Association – No outside ammo is permitted to be brought to the club for league.

**COMMUNICATIONS** – will be made through parents email and text messages **ONLY**. There will be no direct student contact by the league.

**SIGN UPS** – Feb 25 @ PC HS Cafeteria, and Sundays during March before 3/23/20 @ 3pm at the Cresson Sportsmans Clubhouse.

**TEAM** – Every member will shoot every week and scores are reported to USCTA. There will be **NO** non shooters on the team.

**USCTA** – Rules and Scoring Governed by the United States Clay Target Associations.

**CERTIFICATION** – all students **MUST** take a 4-5 hour online **SAFETY** and Instructional course online prior to start of league, info to follow.

**SAFETY – SAFETY – SAFETY – IS OUR NUMBER ONE GOAL!** Anyone who violates ANY safety rules will be asked to leave and will be permanently banned from the team and ANY USCTA organizations in the future!

**PA Hunters Safety Course** – Must be taken and successfully passed prior to start of the league. CCSA will put one on if students do not have one yet.

**Trap Guns** – Please bring your own if you have one, otherwise guns will be available if needed at shoots.

**Season** – Starts on March 29th and will run for 9 weeks. Shoots will be held on primarily on Sundays at CCSA. Other days will be made available weekly for unforeseen circumstances and weather delays.

**Work Hours** – There is a required minimum of 4 hours of work time to be completed by each student around the Cresson Sportsmans Club. Organized work parties will occur and should be attended. These hours will include light labor such as cleanup of clay targets / wads, loading unloading boxes, range maintenance, and other items necessary to keep the club clean, adding to their responsibility.
